The Health Benefit Packages under Chief Minister Health Insurance Scheme (CMHIS) for Employees and Pensioners have been revised to rationalize the rates and incentives have been restructured taking the prevalent Tier-2 city rates as the base rate. The revised rates and incentive structure will come into effect from 1st April 2024.

Additional incentives over and above the Base Package Rates

Table 1: Incentive Criteria & Gradation

Incentive Criteria	Incentive Gradation Above Base Package Rate ¹
1) Full NABH/ Joint Commission International (JCI) Accreditation	15%
2) Entry Level NABH / NQAS Certification	10%
3) Running PG / DNB Course in the Empaneled Specialty	10%
Private Hospitals based in Nagaland	20%
5) Semi-Private Hospitals (NHAK)/ Tier 1 Cities	10%
6) Tier 3 Cities	-10%
7) Nagaland Public Hospitals	-20%
8) NABL (for Lab Diagnostics / Investigation Procedures)	15%

Note:

- 1) Base Package Rate: Nagaland HBP 2024 for CMHIS (EP) is based on the revised rates taking the tier 2 cities package rate as the base rate.
- 2) These percentage incentives are added by compounding.
- 3) Incentive will be applicable for all surgical procedures, dialysis and room charges only.
- 4) Above incentives will not be applicable on the following:
 - Medicines and Consumables which are to be booked at actual cost
 - ii) Implants
- 5) Post surgical hospitalization drugs/consumables/investigations cost capped at Rs. 10,000 in addition to the fixed surgical package.
- 6) Surgical package rate is inclusive of procedures, diagnostics, medicines, consumables and room rent while ICU is permissible and is to be billed separately in the event of complication needing ICU intervention.
- 7) Implants wherever required should be booked as an Add On procedure. If the beneficiary insists on high end implants which is beyond the package rate, the additional cost beyond the package rate will be borne by the patient provided a written consent is obtained from the concerned patient.
- 8) Relaxation: If the beneficiary insists on room facility which is beyond his/her entitlement, the additional cost beyond the entitled room rent will be borne by the patient provided a written consent is obtained from the concerned patient.
- 9) If the beneficiary wants to undertake a diagnostic test(s) which is not related to the ongoing treatment or health event, the cost of the diagnostic test(s) will be borne by the patient.
